Oral presentations will be 20 minutes each and should be based on mental health clinical Nursing interventions, quality initiatives, examples of good practice or evidenced based practice initiatives, service user outcomes, service innovations that are currently taking place. The oral presentations will be catagorised under the following care groups:

- Acute Mental Health Services
- Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service
- Psychiatry of Later Life & Mental Health of Intellectual Disability

The abstract (250 words maximum) should be typed in Times New Roman, Font 12, 1.5 spacing and based on the following headings:

(d) **Outcome/Results:** of the initiative e.g. the end measure/improvement of the initiative

(e) Plan for sustainability/future plans: outline the plan for the future.

Submissions will be reviewed by the National Mental Health Conference Steering Group.
