Subject: HR Memo – Haddington Road Agreement (HRA) hours reversal –

update from HR Memo of 26th May

## Dear Colleagues,

Further to the attached memo dated 26<sup>th</sup> May 2022, the Department has recently confirmed the reduction in HRA hours for Consultants, which are now to be included in the reversal of the HRA.

The below reflects this change and is an updated list of the reduction in standard weekly working hours from July 1, 2022:

- Nursing and Midwifery: 1.5-hour reduction to 37.5 hours per week;
- Specific Health and Social Care Professionals and Medical and Dental: 2-hour reduction to 35 hours per week;

- Management & Administrative: 2-hour reduction to 35 hours per week;
- Specific Medical and Dental Grades (excluding NCHDs): 2-hour reduction;
   and
- Consultants 2-hour reduction for Consultants that are on 39 hours per week (to 37 hours per week) \*update from 26<sup>th</sup> May Memo\*

## In order to have this change reflected for Consultants, local HR Departments are required to:

- Identify Consultants encompassed by the revised HRA hours as outlined above, and
- Complete an Organisational Assignment Same Grade Action (reason code 2022 HRA Amendments) on the SAP HR & Payroll system.
