PSYCHIATRIC NURSES' ASSOCIATION GAELTACHT SCHOLARSHIPS.

RULES

The Psychiatric Nurses' Association intends to sponsor up to ten Gaeltacht Scholarships in 2015 to the value of €500 each and two adult scholarships for members to the value of €350 each.

- The PNA will not determine which Gaeltacht college or area that the successful candidate must attend other than that it must be a bona fide Gaeltacht college.
- ➤ In addition to the PNA scholarship should the successful candidate decide to use one of the three Gael Linn colleges they will provide additional sponsorship as follows:
 - ➤ €250 for a three week course
- ➤ Age Limit is over 11 years and under 18 years on the 1st July each year (i.e. July '15 for this year's candidates)
- > One Application per Member per child only.
- ➤ The Application Form must be co-signed by a Branch Officer/Committee Member and must clearly identify the Branch of origin. Failure to do so will render the application invalid.
- Applicants will be asked to indicate if they have an interest in attending a Gael Linn College on the application form. This will enable the PNA, if the candidate is successful, to process the Gael Linn sponsorship.
- The Scholarships will be awarded by Lottery Draw at an Officer Board meeting following closing date for applications. Therefore completed Application Forms must be returned to PNA Head Office no later than 5 p.m. on February 13th 2015.
- Winners will be informed in writing.
- There will be a requirement that the successful Candidates will have to confirm acceptance within 21 days of date of notification (date of letter)
- Failure to do so will result in the Scholarship being passed on to another Candidate (A number of stand-by Candidates will also be drawn) and no Reminders will issue.
- > The Scholarship is personal to the winner and is non-transferrable.
- > Previous Winners are not eligible to apply.
- The return of a completed Application Form confers the right on the P.N.A. to publish the names and addresses of the successful Applicants.
- Payment of the €500 Scholarship will only be made after the successful candidate completes the course. Confirmation by the college of attendance and course completion will be required.
- ➤ The PNA will offer a number of Adult Scholarships based on the same general Terms and Conditions. The value of the scholarship will be €350. The adult course is usually of one week duration at a cost of approx €250 plus €100 towards accommodation costs.
