Re: Cut in the Pay of 4 th Year Working Student Nurses/Midwives
Dear
The outgoing Government, in addition to pay cuts, pension levy and increased taxation, which applied to all public servants, have imposed a further pay cut on working 4 th year student nurses/midwives.
The outgoing Government, in making this decision, is in breach of a National Agreement. This explicitly provides for 80% of the minimum of the staff nurse scale to be paid, to the 4 th year working students, for the duration of this 36 week working placement where we replace qualified staff and are an integral part of the ward/unit workforce working all of the shifts (including weekends night duty etc.). Instead the Government have now implemented the following;
 2011 - 76% of the minimum point on the new lower scale; 2012 - 60% of the minimum point on the new lower scale; 2013 - 50% of the minimum point on the new lower scale; 2014 - 40% of the minimum point on the new lower scale; and 2015 - No Payment at all.
As a voter in your constituency, I, together with my extended family, am seeking your explicit answer to the following question;
Will you reverse this unfair and unjust Government decision and vote to restore, immediately, the pay of working 4 th year student nurses/midwives to 80% of the minimum of the current staff nurse scale?
